

SENIOR CITIZEN TUITION WAIVERS

Hudson County residents, who are 65 years or older, may take courses on a space-available basis and have tuition waived if the requirements below are met:

- Students who register prior to the designated date cannot apply the Senior Citizen Waiver towards the cost of such courses. The dropping of courses will not be allowed for use of
- If a student is eligible for Financial Aid, the Aid will first be applied against Tuition and Waived Fees. Remaining Aid, if any, will be applied against the fees that are the responsibility of the student.
- HCCC will waive Tuition, Student Activity Fee, Technology Fee, and General Service Fee. Students are responsible to pay Registration Fee and all other Fees, which are due on the day of registration. The College portion of the Tuition Waiver will not be applied until after all Student portion of fees are paid, and after the last day to withdraw from the semester.
